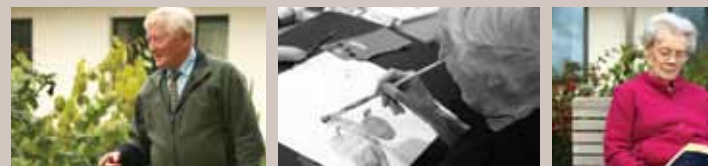

## Mental Health Facility - Bloomfield Hospital

Bloomfield Hospital is a mental health approved centre, registered with the Mental Health Commission. The core specialisation is care of adults with conditions such as dementia and other serious and enduring mental health care needs.

Residents are cared for by a Clinical Director whose team includes a Consultant Psychiatrist, Medical Superintendent, nurses and a variety of therapists. Specialist mental health care is provided in conjunction with Tallaght and St. James' Hospitals.

## Nursing and Retirement Home - New Lodge Nursing Home

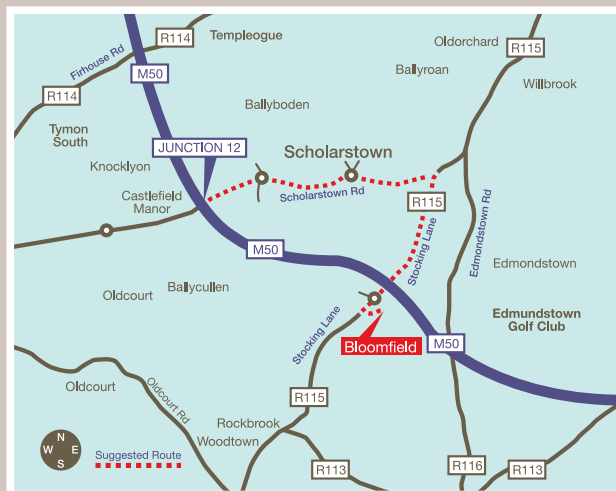
New Lodge is a HIQA registered nursing home. All bedrooms are en suite, with individual patio doors opening onto a beautifully laid out courtyard garden, with bird tables, sculptures and a fish pond. Residents can avail of a variety of ability-related activities and they can welcome guests in either their rooms or shared areas. All have access to 24 hour professional nursing and dedicated medical support.
